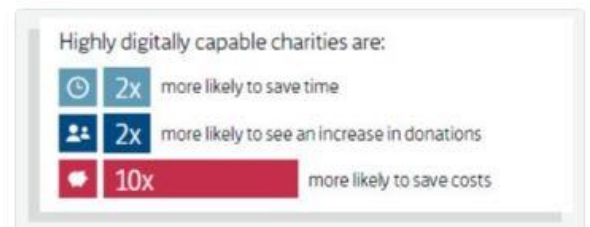
### LATEST DIGITAL MATURITY OF CHARITIES REPORT – UPDATE & WM NEWS
