Launch of #BrumCharityHour



On Feb 2nd, BVSC, the infrastructure charity Birmingham Voluntary Service Council, launched a charity Twitter hour for Birmingham-based charities, using the hashtag #BrumCharityHour. This follows several other geographic-based Twitter hours or chats which happen at a specific time each week including #BrumHour and

#MidlandsHour. These are real-time discussions, usually at a recurring day or time, which focus on a particular industry or interest, in this case, charities in Birmingham.
